### Message from Mr. David Méndez

Dear Families,

At Green Valley School and within the Diploma Programme, the month of October is a crucial month for DP2 students and the time to start working on

components for DP1.

In DP2 our students are working hard to complete their final drafts of the papers that will be sent to IB for external correction. These are crucial moments when students must present the best versions of their work to IB for external correction.

Students must submit the best versions of their research papers for final feedback from their supervisors. Final comments from the supervisors (teachers at the school who have accompanied the student in the research).

This moment is prior to the final version that the students will hand in during the following months.

This is prior to the last version of the work that students will submit in December and January for submission to IB.

In addition, DP2 students continue to work on their preparation for the oral exams in English, Spanish, German and French which will take place in the coming weeks.

This component has a very important percentage of the grade within the language subjects and it is

a first contact with the Diploma Programme final exam.

In DP1, students are working in each subject area on assimilating IB approaches to learning and acquiring skills necessary for learning approaches of the International Baccalaureate and acquiring the necessary skills to prepare for the different assessment components of each subject.

Also, the contact with the core of the Diploma Programme has been very enriching, as the motivation of the students with CAS, initiating several projects of Creativity, Action and Service; Extended Essay with the choice of the research papers of all the students work of all of them to be carried out during the next 15 months and Theory of Knowledge, where they are working on choosing their essay and acquiring the necessary skills for writing it.
